- a. Brewster presented survey results on faculty feedback regarding promotion and tenure updates.
- b. Specific concerns about evaluations, peer review processes, and campus inclusivity were noted.

11. Report from Associate Provost Lou Slimak – Updates on HLC Self-Study, Blackboard Ultra

- a. The HLC Self-Study report has been submitted. Lou provided an overview of survey results and preparation for the upcoming site visit.
 - i. Student survey responses were very similar to the same survey administered in 2018. Roughly 200 written responses received, closely split between positive and negative, with academic advising being the largest point of focus.
- b. Updates on transitioning to Blackboard Ultra were shared, including timelines and expectations for faculty compliance.
 - i. Summer 2025 is the last term with eCampus Original as the default version. Fall 2025 and onward will use Ultra by default.
 - ii. Faculty are encouraged to request development shells from ITS to gain familiarity.
 - iii. eCampus Original will be retired on March 23, 2026.
